Pablo Atchugarry, supported by the Contini Gallery since 2019, has conquered the art world with his creations that unleash the expressive power of matter. His abstract sculptures, which fuse his Renaissance heritage with a contemporary aesthetic, reveal his mastery in the interaction with light, which becomes an integral part of his works.

The exhibition 'Formas Eternas' represents a journey through sculpture, nature and contemporary art, an experience not to be missed by all lovers of art and culture. The official opening with the presence of the artist will take place on 7 June, but the works are already on display and will be on show until 30 September 2025.
