Biography

Julio Larraz was born in Havana, Cuba on March 12th, 1944. Son of Julio Fernandez, a newspaper editor, Larraz began his artistic endeavor from an early age. In 1961, fearing for their safety under Castro's regime, his family left Cuba and moved to the USA. In New York Julio Larraz began drawing politically charged caricatures that acquire great visibility from the start and end up being published on the "New York Times", the "Washington Post", the "Chicago Tribune" e on "Vogue" magazine, to name a few.

In 1967 Larraz kickstarted his full-time career as a painter, which allowed him to meet with several artists including Burt Silverman, whom he credits for having taught him various painting techniques. In 1971 he held his first solo exhibition at Pyramid Galleries in Washington. This event allowed him to gain international recognition opening to the possibility of collaborating with many renowned Art Galleries worldwide. The 1970s were a fruitful decade for the artist. In 1972 he held an exhibition at the New York School for Social Research in New York and, a year later, held another show at the FAR Gallery, New York. In 1976 he won awards from the American Academy of Arts and Letters and the National Institute of Arts and Letters. That same year, he was also awarded the Cintas grant from the Institute of International Education.

In 1977, enticed by the light and atmosphere of the barren hills of the Hondo Valley, Larraz moved to San Patricio, New Mexico. There he met Ron Hall, a Texas based art gallery owner, who will become his art dealer. In 1978 Larraz bought a home in Grandview, New York. There he then met Nohra Haime, whose New York gallery represented him until 1994. In 1983 he relocated to Paris, where he lived for two years, after which he relocated to Miami, Florida.

The artist, through irony and abstract invectives, hides a playful moral contestation which embraces numerous themes: politics, landscape, and female subjects, one of his favorite motifs. There are many cultural references to his native Cuba and to the Surrealism movement which, in his art, get tangled up with a clear hostility towards any kind of injustice, prevarication and inequity. Thanks to his extremely detailed technique, vivid fantasy and uniquely dainty touch, he is considered one of the most important contemporary Latin American painters.

In 2005 Julio Larraz began his collaboration with the Contini Art Gallery, with branches in Venice and Cortina d'Ampezzo. His works have been exhibited in numerous solo shows throughout Italy, including the 2007 exhibition titled *Giocchi di Potere* in Pietrasanta. In 2012 *Julio Larraz* exhibited at the Complesso del Vittoriano in Rome and in 2014 *Del mare, del l'aria e di altre storie* at the Puglisi Cosentino Foundation in Catania. Contini Art Gallery hosted the 2016 major retrospective *Omaggio a Julio Larraz* and in 2018, *Viaggio nella Fantasia*, both of them shown in its Venetian venues. Coral Gable Museum in Miami hosted in 2021, another major retrospective of the artist's work.

After spending three years in Florence, he currently works and resides in Miami, Florida.
